Pressmark Pressings Limited is a manufacturing company based in Atherstone, England, producing mainly automotive pressings for worldwide markets. We employ approximately 80 people and processes used include stamping and welding of mostly steel and aluminium components.

Pressmark Pressings Limited will, through the implementation of its Environmental Management System, Policy and procedures, comply with relevant Environmental legislation and regulations, and they will prevent pollution and continuously endeavour to reduce and minimise its impact on the environment.
